### CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE 1<sup>ST</sup> PRE-INTERNSHIP/ELIGIBILITY EXAMS 2019.

All eligible candidates are hereby informed that the 1<sup>st</sup> pre-internship/eligibility exam 2019 has been scheduled on Thursday the 28<sup>th</sup> of February 2019 for the written exam from 9:00am-12:00noon and the oral exam on Friday the 1<sup>st</sup> of March 2019 starting at 9:00am.

The examination shall be conducted at Makerere University Pharmacy Department.

Applications for the exam should be submitted by the 19<sup>th</sup> of February 2019. An examination fee of 250,000/= shall be applicable for Ugandans while USD 200 shall be applicable for non-Ugandans.

Online applications shall be filed through the PSU website on [www.psucop.com](http://www.psucop.com) with necessary attachments while hardcopy applications shall be filed through the PSU secretariat from which the application forms shall be availed.

All should have completed their courses successfully.

## MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS TO BE ELIGIBLE TO SIT PRE-INTERNSHIP EXAMS

This is to inform all those who wish to sit pre-internship exams that the Pharmaceutical Society of Uganda (PSU) requires one to have successfully completed his/her B.Pharm degree from a recognized University/Institution by the council PSU and should have attained a minimum of two principal passes in the basic science subjects i.e Chemistry, Biology and Physics or its equivalent at A' level.

Persons who fall short of these minimum requirements are required to undertake a **bridging course**.

Please Note that Cases where you have attained your pre-university education from abroad, you will be required to take your academic papers to the Uganda National Examination Board (UNEB) to equate them in the Ugandan standard or rating.

### **Additional requirements**

1. Written/Typed application letter addressed to the Secretary Pharmaceutical Society of Uganda
2. Pre-internship/Eligibility application form (Can be downloaded from PSU Website or Picked from PSU offices at Pharmacy House located in Kyambogo Band).
3. Pre-internship/Eligibility online application done through the PSU website [www.psucop.com](http://www.psucop.com)
4. Curriculum vitae (C.V)
5. Admission letter
6. Certified academic transcript or its equivalent
7. Certified degree certificate
8. Copy of A 'level Certificate or its equivalent
9. Copy of O 'level Certificate or its equivalent
10. Copy of Primary Leaving Education (PLE) Certificate or its equivalent
11. Copy of Birth Certificate
12. Proof of payment of Examination fees. For Ugandans 250,000/= (Two hundred fifty thousand Shillings only) and non-Ugandan 200 Dollars.
13. PSU branded Plastic Spring file 10,000/= (Ten thousand shillings only). Should be banked with Examination fees.
14. One colored passport photo.

### **Applicants re-siting the exam should submit:-**

1. Written/Typed application letter addressed to the Secretary Pharmaceutical Society of Uganda
2. Copy of previous pre-internship results.
3. Proof of payment of Examination fees. For Ugandans 250,000/= (Two hundred fifty thousand Shillings only) and non-Ugandan 200 Dollars.
