APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY REGISTRATION/PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATE OF PRACTICE

Reference is made to the General Notice on Medical Internship FY 2024/2025 by the Ministry of Health regarding the process of admitting medical interns into the internship training program for cohort 2024/2025.

This, therefore, is to inform all prospective Intern Pharmacists to apply for the temporary registration/provisional certificate of practice by 9th July 2024.

Applicants must have pursued an accredited Bachelor of Pharmacy degree program from the onset, sat and passed the PSU pre-internship examinations.

Applications should be done through the PSU online portal www.psupcop.com as guided below;

1. Sign into your account with your username and password registered at the time of applying for the PSU pre-internship examination. In case you no longer remember your login credentials, please click "I forgot my password" and then fill in the email address used at the time of registering the account.
2. Click Provisional COP
3. Click Apply for Provisional Certificate
4. Fill in the required information
 - a) Gender
 - b) Citizenship
 - c) Name of University
 - d) Year of Completion/graduation at the University
 - e) PSU Pre-internship Examination Number
 - f) NIN (Ugandans) / Passport Number(Non-Ugandans)
5. Attach/Upload a clear copy of;
 - a) National ID(Both sides on one page) / Copy of Passport
 - b) Evidence of passing pre-internship Exams.
 - c) Proof of payment of UGX 100,000/= (Application fee) Banked on 9030005895331 Stanbic Bank. Use Stanbic bank branches and Stanbic bank agents only. **Please note;** Avoid Mobile Money payments at this stage.

Upon deployment, you will be required to update your application with the approved internship center and council-approved supervisor's name, email address, and phone number then sign the PSU mentorship agreement (Refer to the Mentorship Guide on PSU website).
