RE: NOTICE OF RELEASE OF 1ST PRE-INTERNSHIP EXAMS RESULTS 2026

At its 54th Emergency Council Meeting held on 30th January 2026, the Council of the Pharmaceutical Society of Uganda, in exercise of its statutory mandate, considered the results of the 1st Pre-Internship Examinations 2026, which were administered on 22nd January 2026.

A total of 170 candidates sat for the examination, out of whom 75 candidates scored 50% and above, representing a 44% pass rate. The highest score attained was 66%, while the lowest score was 16%. Overall performance was better in questions assessing knowledge and understanding of Pharmacognosy and Ethics and Regulation, whereas questions assessing Clinical Pharmacy and Hospital Practice/Pharmacology were poorly performed.

Individual examination scores will be communicated to candidates through their personal accounts on the PSU Portal (<https://psuapp.cemug.com>) Sunday, 1st February 2026 by 10:00 a.m. Official result letters will be available for collection starting Wednesday, 4th February 2026, from 2:00 p.m.

All candidates who did not attain the pass mark are hereby invited to attend a mandatory meeting scheduled as follows:
