## APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY REGISTRATION/PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATE OF PRACTICE 2026/2027

This is to invite those who have sat and passed the PSU Pre-internship exams to apply for the temporary registration/provisional certificate of practice by 24<sup>th</sup> June 2026. Applicants must have pursued an accredited Bachelor of Pharmacy degree program from the onset. The PSU pre-internship examinations results are valid for a period of two years from the date of their release.

Applications should be done through the PSU online portal [www.psupcop.com](http://www.psupcop.com) as guided below;

1. Sign into your account with your username and password registered at the time of applying for the PSU pre-internship examination. In case you no longer remember your login credentials, please click "[I forgot my password](#)" and then fill in the email address used at the time of registering the account.
2. Click Provisional COP
3. Click Apply for Provisional Certificate
4. Fill in the required information
  - a) Gender
  - b) Citizenship
  - c) Name of University
  - d) Year of Completion/graduation at the University
  - e) PSU Pre-internship Examination Number
  - f) NIN (Ugandans) / Passport Number(Non-Ugandans)
5. Attach/Upload a clear copy of;
  - a) Valid National ID. For those without national ID , attach LC 1 Village ID and evidence of applying for national ID.Evidence of passing pre-internship Exams.
  - b) Proof of payment of UGX 210,000/= for provisional certificate of practice, a clinical coat, copy of BNF and copy of Uganda Clinical Guidelines. Payment should be made on Account number 9030005895331 Stanbic Bank. Use Stanbic bank branches and Stanbic bank agents only.

Upon deployment, you will be required to update your application online with the approved internship center and council-approved supervisor's name, email address, and phone number, then sign the PSU mentorship agreement (Refer to the Mentorship Guide on the PSU website under Notices, or Resources & Downloads).
