2. **Secretary:** at least three (03) years of PSU membership

RULES AND GUIDELINES FOR PSU ELECTIONS 2026/2027

The members of the pharmaceutical society of Uganda.

SUBJECT: **GUIDELINES FOR ELECTION OF PSU SECRETARY AND TREASURER.**

1.0 Correspondences

1.1 Correspondences related to the conduct of the elections should be made in writing by email to the chairperson PSU EC 2026/2027.

2.0 Applicable laws

2.1 The constitution of Uganda, 1995 as amended.

2.2 The pharmacy and drugs act, cap 309.

2.3 The PSU byelaws on elections.

3.0 Nominations

3.1 The nominator and Seconders MUST be registered and fully paid-up members of the Pharmaceutical Society of Uganda.

3.2 The Nominee should be a registered and fully paid-up member of the Pharmaceutical Society of Uganda.

3.3 Aspiring candidates should be nominated by a member of the Society, and seconded by a member of the Society.

3.4 The Nominator nominates only one person for the position of Secretary and one person for the position of Treasurer.

3.5 Nominations should be sent by email to *psu.ec2428@gmail.com* and copied to *okirorlema@gmail.com* or hand delivered to the PSU Secretariat not later than 23:59 hours on July 30, 2026. The Subject line should be: PSU NOMINATIONS 2026.

3.6 Nominations should be made on the prescribed Nomination Form that can be downloaded from the PSU website Under Notices. Nominations in any other form and on any other form will be invalid.

4.0 Eligibility for Candidature

4.1 Secretary and Treasurer

Should have been members of the Society for at least three (03) years

4.1.1 Should be fully subscribed for the financial year 2026/2027

4.1.2 Should not, as on the voting day, be in violation of clauses 7, 8, and 9 of the Pharmacy and Drugs Act Cap 309.

5.0 Eligibility to vote

5.1 Should be a fully registered member and fully subscribed for the financial year 2026/2027.

5.2 Should not, as on voting day be in violation of clauses 7, 8, and 9 of the pharmacy and drugs act cap 309

6.0 Observers

6.1 A candidate is limited to two observers.

6.2 A candidate will communicate the names of the observers to the EC in writing (email, letter) before voting commences.

6.3 An observer can be eligible to observe for more than one candidate if the candidates so assign.

6.4 Observers are not allowed to speak on behalf of the EC.

6.5 Observers are expected to be at the polling center throughout the voting until the time of declaration of results.

6.6 Observers will be required to witness receipt and custody of ballot papers from the supplier.

6.7 Observers will sign declarations immediately after counting and tallying.

7.0 Voting process

7.1 Voting will be open at 0800 hours and close at 1600 hours the same day.

7.2 Voting will be by secret ballot.

7.3 A voter will be marked with indelible ink upon receipt of the ballot paper

7.4 The authorized mark of choice is either a Tick or a Thumb print with in the box for the candidate of choice.

7.5 Ballots with marks other than those in 7.4 will be invalid.

7.6 Voters must follow instructions indicated on top of the ballot paper.

8.0 Identification

8.1 Before voting, eligible voters will be identified using one of the following: Valid national identity card (Uganda) or valid PSU identity card, valid driving license, certificate of registration or annual membership certificate.

8.2 All members turning up to vote are requested to present the relevant identification as specified above.

8.3 Surrogate voting or voting by proxy is prohibited

9.0 Obligations

9.1 Members are requested and are expected to exercise and maintain professionalism, self-control and collegiality in the period leading to, during and after elections.

10.0 Election control and oversight.

10.1 The EC will confirm voter eligibility at the polling center as per the voter register

10.2 The EC will preside over the entire electoral process

10.3 The EC will be responsible for declaration of results.
