RE: NOTICE OF RELEASE OF 2ND FINAL QUALIFYING/PRE-REGISTRATION EXAMINATIONS RESULTS 2026

At its 59th Emergency Council Meeting held on 2nd September 2026, the Council of the Pharmaceutical Society of Uganda, in exercise of its statutory mandate, considered the results of the 2nd Final Qualifying/Pre-Registration Examinations 2026, which were administered on 27th August 2026.

A total of 299 candidates sat the examination out of which 272 candidates scored 50% and above, representing 91% pass rate while 27 candidates scored below 50%, representing 9% fail rate. The highest mark scored was 78% while the lowest score was 23%.

Subject to the PSU Examination guidelines 2024, the areas examined were ;

1. Clinical pharmacy/pharmaceutical care
2. Medicines and Supply Chain Management
3. General/Hospital/Community pharmacy practice
4. Drug Regulation and Pharmacy Law
5. Pharmaceutical manufacturing/industrial pharmacy practice
6. Professionalism and Ethics

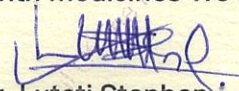
Questions assessing knowledge and skills in General Hospital/Community pharmacy practice and clinical pharmacy were fairly done relative to other areas. The high pass rate in this examination may be attributed to better preparation of the candidates for the examination, the record better performance at pre-internship for the same cohort, the support of the Secretariat and improvements in internship training.

Official result letters will be available for collection starting Friday, 4th September 2026, from 2:00 p.m at Pharmacy house.

Congratulation to all who have passed. Those for another try, the examination shall be held in February 2027. Meanwhile the results (Scores) can be viewed through the PSU application portal that you used for applying.
